Before starting your e-learning development project, it's important to consider how accessible your course needs to be to meet your learner's unique needs. At Yukon Learning, we offer two levels of accessibility: **Standard** and **Advanced**.

Let's review what each level entails...

Standard

- Written Transcript
- Audio Narration with Closed Captioning
- Color Contrast Ratio Checks
- Avoidance of Ableist Language
(i.e. *click, hear, see*)

Advanced

Everything included in the **Standard** level AND:

- Keyboard navigation and screen reader support
- Focus order for navigating elements on slide
- Accessible text styles
- Alternate text on imagery
- Navigation help slide
- Avoiding inaccessible interactions
(i.e. *drag and drops that require mouse mobility and hotspots that require vision*)

 We target WCAG 2.2 Level AA Compliance.
